## **Definitions**

<u>Hepatitis B</u> = Hepatitis B Vaccine

<u>DTaP</u> = Diphtheria and Tetanus Toxoids, and Acellular Pertussis

**Hib** = Haemophilus influenzae type b Conjugate Vaccine

<u>IPV</u> = Inactivated Poliovirus (polio vaccine)

## Rotavirus

<u>Pneumococcal (Prevnar)</u> = Pneumococcal 13-valent Conjugate Vaccine

<u>Hepatitis A</u> = Hepatitis A Vaccine

 $\underline{\mathbf{MMR}}$  = Measles, Mumps, and Rubella Virus Vaccine

<u>Varicella</u> = (Chickenpox) Vaccine

 $\underline{\mathsf{TB}}$  = Tuberculosis Skin Test

**Meningococcal** = Menactra Vaccine

<u>Tdap</u> = DTap for adolescents and adults

<u>HPV</u> = Human Papillomavirus Vaccine. \*Two doses for ages 9-14. 3 doses for ages 15-26.

**FVA** = Fluoride Varnish Application

Our well visit and vaccination schedule is based on the <u>Standard Vaccine Schedule</u> recommended by CDC.
